2	Comparison	Select the comparison. <b>Only National is available until 30 cases have been entered.</b>
3	Display	Select the Display: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Scores</b>—shows the raw scores for the composite and individual measures.</li> <li>• <b>Percentiles</b>—shows the percentiles for the composite and individual measures.</li> </ul>
4	View/Refresh	Click after selecting the options.
5	Individual Measures	This is where you will see the Individual measures, which comprise the battery. <b>Note:</b> Optional measures are shown in gray and not required to get a composite score.
6	Individual Measure Score	Click this to view the popup with the score details.

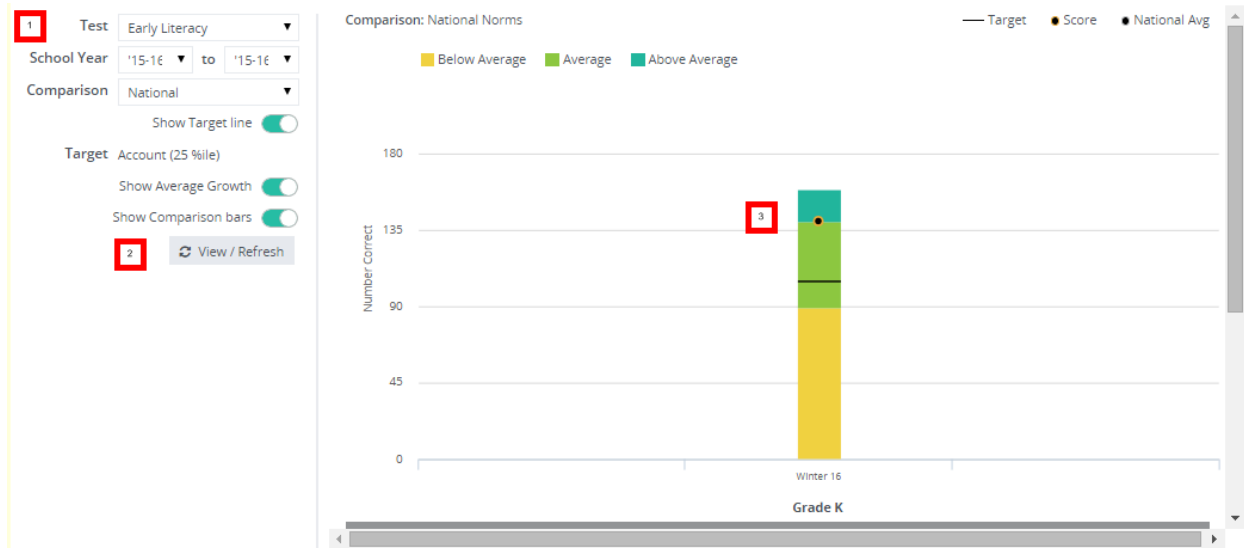

**What do these early literacy scores mean?**  
This graph shows Sample 7's Winter benchmark test results compared to a national sample of kindergarten students.

**At the skill level, Sample 7's score on...**

- 3** ■ **Initial Sounds** shows an average ability to identify and make the first sounds of familiar words.
- **Letter Naming Fluency** shows an average ability to name upper- and lower-case letters.  
This score should be interpreted with caution because the test session was either interrupted or repeated.

**What does these Early Literacy Composite score mean?**  
Sample 7's Early Literacy Composite national percentile score is 76, which is above average. This score is above the 80% line. Students with scores in this range have a greater than 80% chance of achieving spring performance goals. Sample 7's risk level is low.

**At the composite level, Sample 7's score is above average.**

**Recommendation**  
Based on Sample 7's above average performance on the Early Literacy Composite, this student should continue to benefit from the current literacy curriculum.
